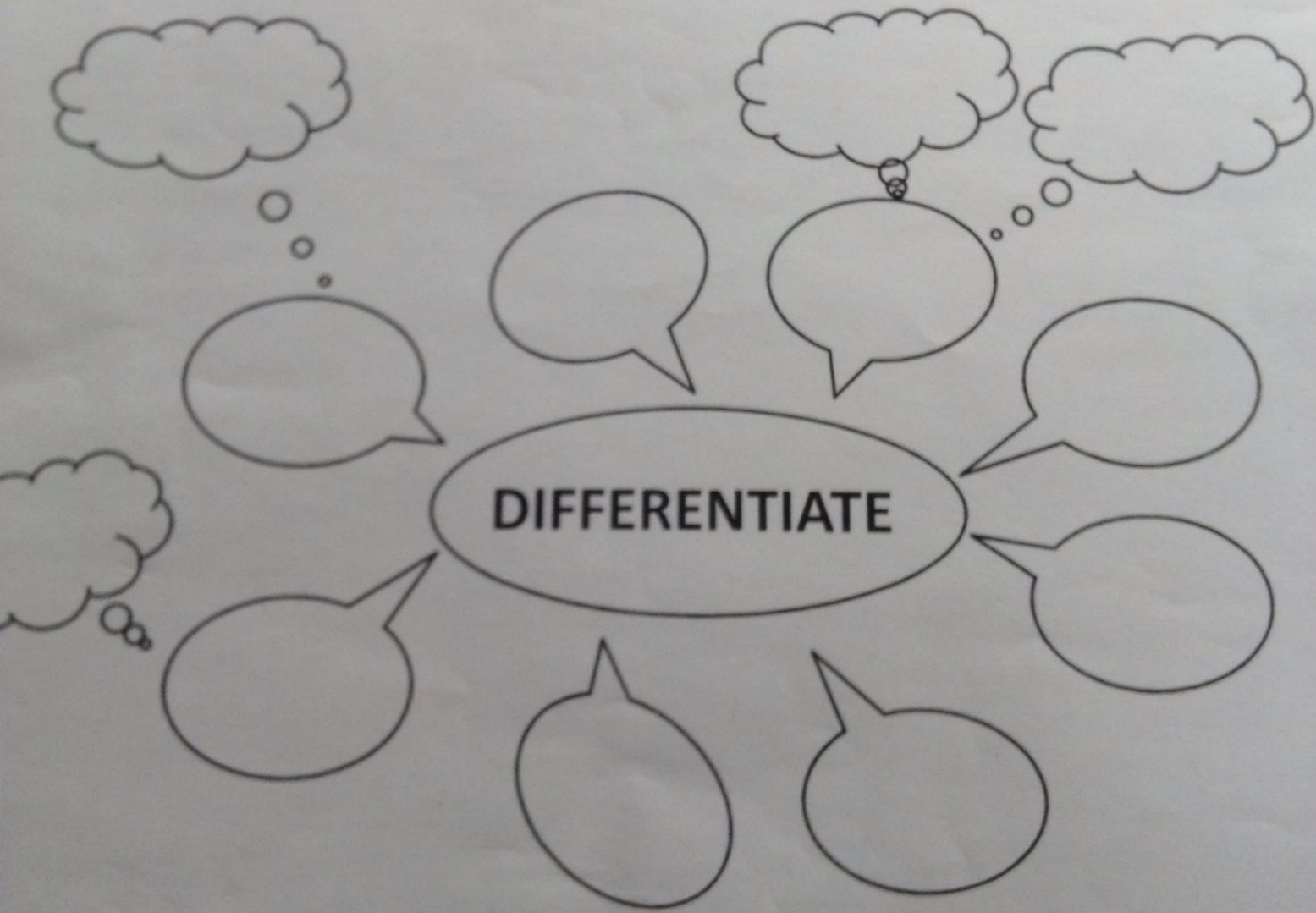

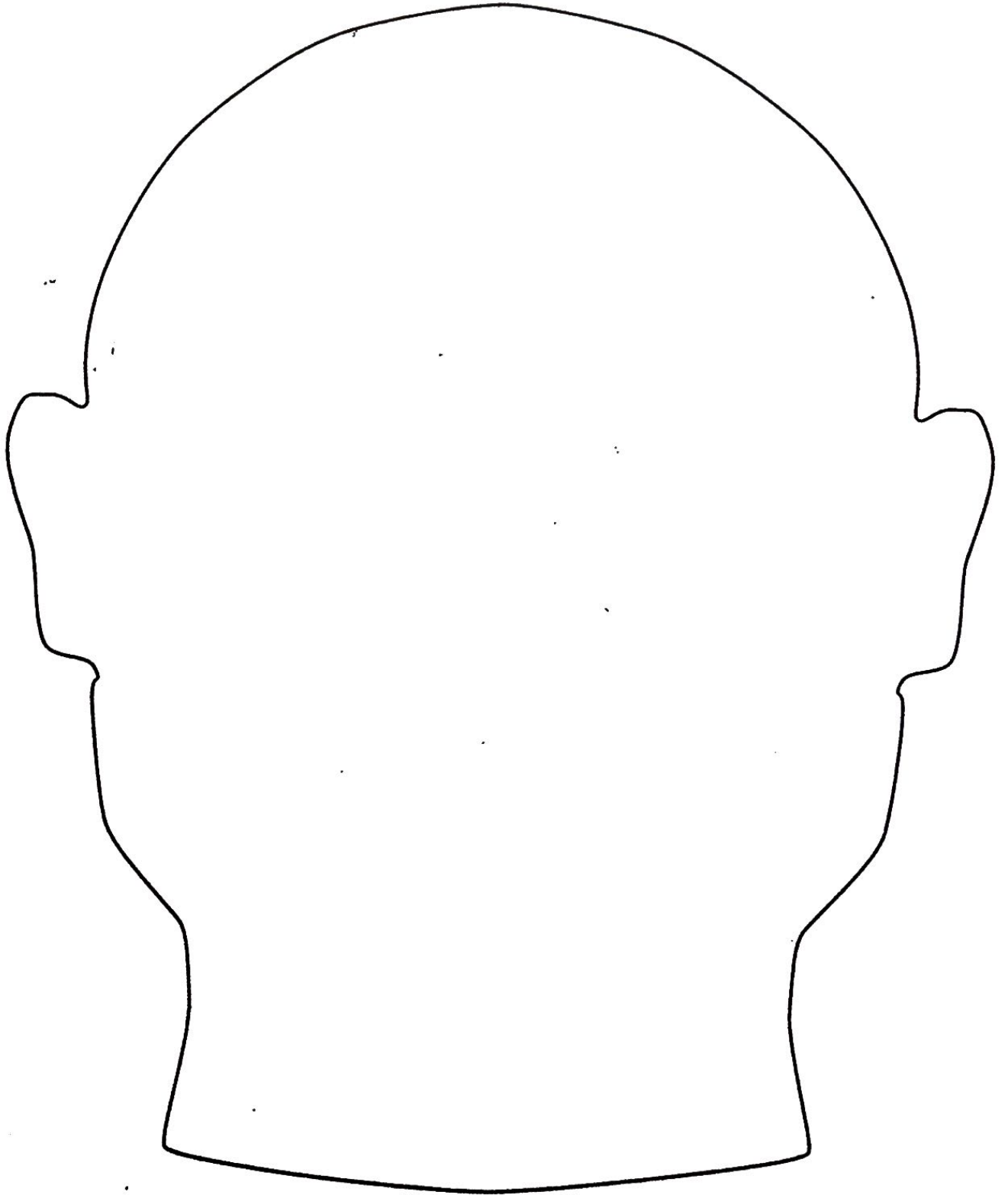

Bounce Card

Bounce:

Take what your classmate(s) said and bounce an idea off of it. For example, you can start your sentences with:

Sum It Up:

Rephrase what was just said in a shorter version. For example, you can start your sentences with:

Inquire:

Understand what your classmates mean by asking questions. For example, you can start your sentences with:

- “Can you tell me more about that?”
- “I see your point, but what about ...”
- “Have you thought about...”

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
